

## **Farm Water Security Project Workshop**

Our farm water security project, in collaboration with Federation University's Centre for eResearch and Digital Innovation (CeRDI), involved sampling and analysing water from farm bores across our region and mapping surface water flows and dam catchments to tally farm water storage and assess the potential impacts of climate change.

At our final workshop CeRDI GIS specialist Rick Pope demonstrated the farm dam catchment analysis and climate change predictions available on the NRM Planning Portal, and hydrogeologist Pete Dahlhaus (Assoc Prof) provided some fascinating insight into groundwater in our region and went over the results of bore sampling.

#### **Herbicide Resistance Guest Speaker**

Guest speaker Dr. David Brunton is a local farmer and Landcare member who recently completed a PhD in herbicide resistance. He began with an intro to herbicide resistance and shared recent ryegrass resistance data from our region, which showed a concerning situation for glyphosate resistance, as well as complex and evolving situation for selective pre-emergent herbicides (Group 15 – Formerly J and K). Paraquat resistance remains rare.

We then discussed herbicide resistance management. Best practice starts with rotating crops and herbicide mode of action groups, and working in non-chemical weed control tactics such as harvest weed seed control. David also stressed the importance of resistance testing to inform herbicide choice and demonstrated the cost of undiagnosed resistance both in terms of wasted product and crop yield loss.

It was great to welcome attendees of diverse ages and backgrounds, from smallholders new to the area to farmers with extensive agronomy experience. If you wis to receive a copy of the presentation, please email Alicia.
